If it's a stray, stay away!

The Northeast District Department of Health has received increased reports of rabid and potentially rabid animals.



Protect yourself and your pets
by staying away from animals that are unfamiliar to you!

- Rabies is a deadly disease caused by a virus that can infect animals such as raccoons, skunks, woodchucks, bats, foxes, dogs, cats, AND PEOPLE.
- Rabies is transmitted primarily through the bite of a rabid animal.



If YOU are bitten:

- Wash the wound good with soap and water
- Seek medical treatment
- Call NDDH at 860-774-7350

If your pet has been bitten:

- Wear gloves before handling your pet
- Contact your veterinarian
- Call your local animal control officer at _____
