Vaccines Available	For Ages	# of shots needed to be fully vaccinated	WHEN you can get a COVID-19 booster
Pfizer	5+	2 (21 days apart) Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian	At least 6 months after a second dose of Pfizer or Moderna
Moderna	18+	2 (28 days apart)	
Johnson & Johnson	18+	1	At least 2 months after a J & J vaccine

*You may have a preference, but you can receive **any** authorized COVID-19 vaccine as a booster.*
