# Plan a Raid on Radon

Radon is an odorless, invisible, radioactive gas that can build up in homes and buildings putting people at risk. Anyone can get lung cancer from breathing in high levels of radon over time, whether or not you smoke. Take these simple steps to reduce your risk:

- 1. Get a free radon test kit from NDDH while supplies last**
- 2. Test your home for radon**
- 3. Submit the test kit to the manufacturer for results**
- 4. Fix your home if radon levels are high**



District residents may visit the health department at 69 South Main Street in Brooklyn to receive one free radon test kit per home. You will receive a follow-up call to assure that the kit was used and returned to the manufacturer according to instructions. NDDH is unable to reserve kits or mail them.
